

## Cattle Concentrate Pellets

*A feedlot pellet mixed with farmers' grain for lot feeding beef cattle and ensuring prime beef production. Maximises feed conversion and achieves mortal weight rapidly.*

### Mixing Instructions

Wheat 10.5%	200kg	Lupins/Beans	110kg
Barley 11.5%	650kg	Concentrate	40kg

### Feeding Instructions

Feed 2.5-3.5% bodyweight of concentrate feed for fattening. Roughage content of the diet should range from 7% to 20% of total ration. Contains enough protein for straight grain to provide a complete balance with just single extra additions of 2% Bentonite and 5-7% hay/straw (if possible). If roughage cannot be blended with the grain, free choice hay/straw should be made available.

### Ingredients

Mill Run, Limestone, Salt, Urea, Palfos, Beef Premix, Mondox, Tylan 50.

WARNING – CONTAINS UREA

### Directions for use

Keep dry: when wet, urea can become soluble and lead to urea toxicity. Introduce slowly and always ensure adequate 'gut-fill' of forage before introducing feed supplements (use this product at a lower inclusion rate for one week before going to the recommended rate). Forage should be provided with the ration or offered ad lib.

### Precautions

Feeding this product to horses or other equines may be fatal.
